#### Performance time is not to exceed 4 minutes (one piece only)

Each pianist is to:

On arrival: Register + provide a photocopy of your performance music

Prior to your performance announce: 1. Your name 2. How long you have been playing the piano 3. Title of your piece

### Adjudication:

· Each performance will be commented on in a way that will provide useful feedback for enhancing performance.

Adjudicators will be assessing:

Stage presentation, performance related to experience, technique, interpretation, dynamics and musicality.

• Award Certificates will be presented at the end of each section.





## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. All entrants in the LEJMC must be of Primary or Intermediate School age, ie; up to year 8.

2. PERFORMANCE TIME IS NOT TO EXCEED 4 MINUTES (one piece only).

3. Performers must be ready and SEATED at the venue PRIOR TO THE SECTION START TIME.

4. Please provide a photocopy of the performance music (if not included with Entry Form). Clearly mark "Adjudicators copy only".

5. **Important Copyright Notice:** Any copies of music made for the Adjudicators will be withheld by the LEJMC and destroyed at the conclusion of the Contest.

6. Overall assessment and awards of Gold, Silver and Bronze will be made following each section.

7. The 'Irene Rhodes-Beck Memorial Award for Piano' certificate to be awarded for outstanding performance.

8. The 'Lewis Eady Piano Cup' will awarded to the most promising pianist.

9. The Contest Programme will be available online (www.lect.co.nz) - please note your section start time & Performance No.

10. Section starting times and approximate section breaks will be indicated on the programme and the utmost effort will be made to adhere to these times.

11. Performers 'Adjudicator Report Sheets' will be made available at the end of each section.
